



SMOKING POLICY

1. PURPOSE

This policy outlines our procedures for tobacco and e-cigarette use in club venues and at club games, special events, functions and other club-related activities.

2. RATIONALE

Sea Lake Nandaly Tigers Football Netball Club Inc recognises that environmental (second-hand) tobacco smoke, and by products from e-cigarettes (including vaping) is a health hazard and that non-smokers should be protected from it. Smoke free areas make smoking less visible and less acceptable, and contribute to reduced uptake of smoking among young people.

3. GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Smoking restrictions for sporting clubs differ from state to state, and are strengthened regularly. Our club will comply with all relevant state and local government smoking restrictions.

4. SMOKE FREE AREAS

Our club requires the following areas of the club's sporting ground to be smoke free (and these areas will be signed where possible):

- All indoor areas and a ten metre exclusion zone from entry and exits from indoor areas, specifically dining rooms and change rooms.
- All outdoor playing/training areas
- A ten metre exclusion zone from entry and exits from indoor areas, specifically dining rooms and change rooms.
- All canteen areas

5. PROMOTING THIS POLICY

Our club will promote this policy regularly by including the policies on our website and having printed copies available in function areas. It will also use social media and promote the GoodSports philosophies.

6. NON-COMPLIANCE

All club committee members will uphold this policy and continued non-compliance will be handled accordingly. A friendly approach will be made to the person smoking, explaining our club policy, and directing them to any areas where smoking is permitted.

7. POLICY REVIEW

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains relevant to club operations and reflects both community expectations and legal requirements.
